Artist aids cancer campaign

LADY FIONA Fraser, vice-chairman of the Ninewells Cancer Campaign, last night accepted a £4000 painting from Aberdeenshire artist Catriona Millar.

The painting is to be auctioned at a forthcoming major charity event, the date of which is yet to be confirmed.

Ms Millar made the donation at a private viewing of her solo exhibition in the Queen's Gallery, Nethergate, last night.

She said two of her cousins recently died of cancer and she wanted to support research into the disease and was aware of the great reputation for cancer research and treatment at Ninewells Hospital.

Lady Fraser said the donation of the painting was greatly appreciated and had given a boost to the campaign chairman, Dr Jacqui Wood, who was herself seriously ill with cancer.

"It is particularly special to come along and receive such a wonderful painting to help us in what we do in the fight towards treatment and research in cancer," Lady Fiona said.

"Since 1990 the campaign has raised around £17 million, all raised by volunteers and all going to work done here in Dundee."

The show opens to the public today and will run until September 27.
